PURPOSE OF SCHOLARSHIP: Sanderson High School *PTO* awards scholarships to selected applicants for the sole purpose of assisting these individuals in their pursuit of continuing education. Accordingly, the scholarships awarded will only be paid to the winning applicant if he/she has been accepted as a student in any accredited university, college, junior college, community college or technical/trade institute as of December 31st in the year in which the scholarship is awarded. If the winning applicant has not been accepted by this date, the scholarship will be forfeited.

HOW SCHOLARSHIPS ARE PAID: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the winning applicant after receipt by the Sanderson *PTO* of documentation indicating that the applicant has been accepted, within time constraints, as a student in any accredited university, college, junior college, community college or technical/trade institute.
