PURPOSE OF SCHOLARSHIP: Sanderson High School *PTO* awards scholarships to selected applicants for the sole purpose of assisting these individuals in their pursuit of continuing education. Accordingly, the scholarships awarded will only be paid to the winning applicant if he/she has been accepted as a student in any accredited university, college, junior college, community college or technical/trade institute as of December 31st in the year in which the scholarship is awarded. If the winning applicant has not been accepted by this date, the scholarship will be forfeited.

HOW SCHOLARSHIPS ARE PAID: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the winning applicant after receipt by the Sanderson *PTO* of documentation indicating that the applicant has been accepted, within time constraints, as a student in any accredited university, college, junior college, community college or technical/trade institute.

DEADLINE: Completed applications must be submitted to the Career Center no later than 2:30 PM on Wednesday, April 1, 2020. Under no circumstances will applications be accepted after this time and date. Applicants are advised to be aware of this deadline and are encouraged to submit their applications early.

INTERVIEWS: Not all applicants may qualify for an interview. Qualifications for an interview will be based on your essay and application. Interviews are before a panel of judges, approximately 10 minutes in length, and will be held after school on **Monday, April 27, 2020**. **This is the ONLY DATE interviews will be conducted.** All applicants will be notified via email if they do or do not qualify for an interview. **Interview schedules will also be posted in the Career Center by Monday, April 20, 2020 in the morning. You are responsible for checking your interview time.** If changes to your interview time are necessary please contact Sarah Glover at sarahglover5@gmail.com or (919) 422-1913.
