

## **May 18, 2020 Sanderson PTO General Meeting Minutes**

Meeting called to order at 7:00pm via virtual meeting platform. 19 members present.

Reviewed February meeting minutes. Motion made and seconded to approve minutes. Motion passed

**President's report:** Vince provided a review of activities of the PTO during this academic year. Highlights included successful No-Fuss Fundraiser (\$16,000 raised, \$10,000 donated to the school), Funding 8 Teacher Grants, multiple successful hospitality events, Successful Teacher Appreciation Week in spite of COVID-19, awarding four scholarships to students.
